Erin Isanhart PT, DPT, NCS is a vestibular and neurologic physical therapist who was involved in the establishment of the Stanford Concussion Clinic in 2014. During her time at Stanford Health Care, Erin has collaborated with the physical therapy team at Stanford Children's Health and Stanford University Athletics to establish their concussion and vestibular physical therapy program. She shares her knowledge in vestibular and concussion rehabilitation as a faculty member for the Orthopedic Physical Therapy and Geriatric Physical Therapy Residency at Stanford Health Care. Erin's passion for teaching extends beyond Stanford Health Care and into the broader community via California Concussion Institute and through guest lecturing in similar venues.

Erin studied at the University of Pittsburgh where she earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Rehabilitation Sciences in 2004. She continued her studies there to obtain a Doctorate in Physical Therapy in 2008. She received her competency certification in vestibular therapy at Emory University in 2010. In 2014, she became a Board Certified Clinical Specialist in Neurologic Physical Therapy.

Erin has been working with individuals recovering from vestibular disorders since the beginning of her professional career at Centers for Rehab Services in partnership with The University of Pittsburgh Medical Center. While there, she developed her therapeutic skills working with the vestibular and concussion population. Erin's expertise and proficiency as a vestibular therapist are evident in her many successful outcomes in her work with the concussion population.
